There will be three in-(sessional) semester examinations of one-hour duration for each theory subject to be held as per the schedule fixed in the Academic Calendar. Score of best two of the three insemester exams will be considered.

The assessment laboratory subjects will be based on the student's performance in the practical during the session. Each practical will graded. There will normally be 12 practical's in a semester. Ten best grades awarded to a student, out of the 12, will be considered for deciding the grade of the student.

Sub section 4.3.of Section 4: It is mandatory for the students to appear in the end-semester examination to be eligible for evaluation of grades. The end-semester examination will be conducted centrally by the University.

There will be two in-semester (sessional) examinations of one-hour duration for each theory subject to be held as per the schedule fixed in the Academic Calendar. The allotted marks for the Minor Examinations, attendance and continuous performance will be 20 each, 05 and 05 marks respectively.

The assessment in laboratory subjects will be based on the student's performance in the practical during the session. The in-semester assessment in practicals will be of 50 marks.
