Organised Yoga and Webinar on the theme of “Yoga for One Earth, One Health”



Mangalayatan University celebrated International Yoga Day with great zeal and enthusiasm, and concurrently hosted a national webinar, both aligned with this year's theme, “Yoga for One Earth, One Health.” The on-campus event witnessed active participation from NSS volunteers, as well as teaching and non-teaching staff, while the webinar focused on the impact of yoga on modern lifestyles. MU Launches Courses of Defence and Strategic Studies

In response to evolving global dynamics and India's changing defence needs, Manglayatan University has announced the establishment of the Institute of Defence and Strategic Studies from the academic session 2025–26. The decision was taken during the recent meeting of the university's Academic Council. The newly formed institute aims to promote high-quality education in the fields of Defence Studies, International Relations, and Strategic Policy Making, contributing towards strengthening India as a strategic global power.

Vice Chancellor Prof. P. K. Dashora stated that the institute will offer two four-year undergraduate programmes: B.A. (Defence and Strategic Studies) and B.Sc. (Defence and Strategic Studies). The minimum eligibility for admission is 45% marks in the 12th standard. "These programmes are designed to educate and train students in contemporary



areas such as national defence policy, cyber security, terrorism, foreign policy, and military strategy," Prof. Dashora explained. "The institute will serve as a bridge between academia, the armed forces, and policymakers." Graduates of these programmes will be well-positioned to pursue careers in the Indian Army, Navy, Air Force, paramilitary forces, civil services, intelligence agencies, think tanks, defence journalism, international organizations, and private security consultancy.

National Seminar on Use and Misuse of Tobacco Held



On the occasion of World No Tobacco Day, Manglayatan University hosted a one-day national seminar on the theme "Use and Misuse of Tobacco". The event was organized by the Department of Agriculture in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). 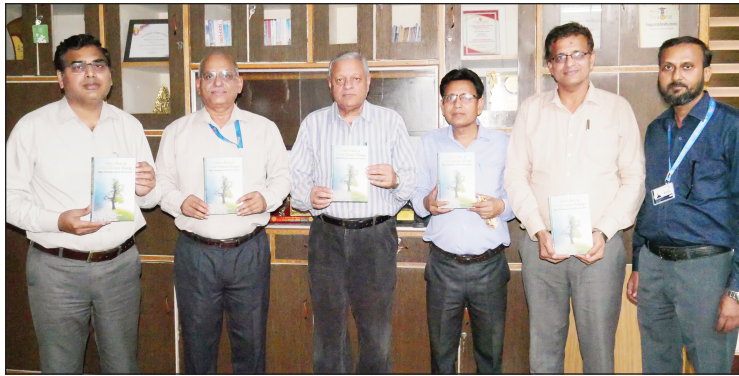
