MOU FOR ACADEMIC & RESEARCH COLLABORATION

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for academic collaboration is made on 27/02/2021 between – Dr B.R Ambedkar University Agra through its Registrar Lt Col (Dr) Anjani Kumar Mishra (Retd) (Hereinafter called the first party)

Mangalayatan University (MU), a private university established under the provisions of the Mangalayatan University Uttar Pradesh Act, 2006, and having its campus at Extended NCR, Mathura - Aligarh Highway, 33d Milestone, Aligarh - 202145, Uttar Pradesh through its Registrar Brig Sumar Vir singh (Retd) (Hereinafter called the second Party)

Both parties hereto, recognising the benefits of establishing links, wish to strengthen the ties between their respective institutions by entering into this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU").

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED

1. The purpose of this MOU is to develop co-operation and promote mutual understanding and excellence in practice-based education, research and knowledge exchange between the Parties, so that the research and knowledge developed is used for regional, national and global well being of humanity.
2. Both parties agree to join hands and carry out collaborative research work by faculty and students in the following areas:-
 - a. To alleviate the sufferings of the local rural & urban people of Aligarh, Agra, and surrounding areas, and improve their quality of life.
 - b. Enhance technology of local industries.
 - c. Work on emerging technologies.
 - d. The outcome could be replicated in other parts of India or elsewhere in the world.
3. Both parties to establish centres of cooperation through mutual agreement. Faculty and students from both Universities to work in these centres.
4. Both will enter into joint research and development activities by initiating writing of detailed project report (DPR) and submission of the project proposal to the funding agency like DBT, DST, CSIR, ICMR, ICAR, or any other national and/ or international funding agencies. The idea is to explore joint research programmes and bring out intellectually



driven product lines and patent generation. Thus, both agree in terms of exchange of information and fostering collaboration in research and educational training programmes.

5. In furtherance of this purpose the Parties agree to develop the following activities in collaboration in areas of mutual academic interest:

- a. Exchanges of students and faculty for study programmes, research and other enhancements to the student experience.
- b. Identifying opportunities for conducting collaborative research and development.
- c. Identifying opportunities for conducting lectures and seminars and organising symposia and conferences.
- d. Exchanges of academic information and materials.
- e. Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest.
- f. Promoting other academic co-operation and collaboration as mutually agreed.

6. The development and implementation of specific activities developed under this MOU will be the subject to formal written agreements negotiated and entered into separately, which will deal with the financial arrangements, confidentiality, ownership and use of intellectual property, publication of articles or other work and other relevant matters.

7. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in MOU shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Parties concerned.

8. Both Parties agree that staff and students of either institution engaged in activities under this MOU shall carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of their respective institutes after full consultation and approval.

9. This MOU may only be amended by a written agreement signed by a duly authorised representative of each Party.

10. This MOU shall commence on the date of its execution by the last Party to sign and shall remain in force for a period of five years. Each Party shall review the status of the MOU at least six months before the end of the five- year period to determine whether it



wishes the MOU to continue and, if so, whether any modifications are required. The period of validity of this MOU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both Parties.


11. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving six months' notice in writing to the other. The termination of this MOU shall not affect the implementation of any specific activities established under it prior to such termination.

12. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationships between the Parties. This MOU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.


13. In the event of any dispute, difference or question arising out of or touching upon or concerning this agreement, the same shall be resolved by both parties through discussions. However, in case of such disputes that cannot be resolved by both parties, then it shall be referred for arbitration to Vice Chancellor of Agra University. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on BOTH PARTIES and no suit shall lie in any Civil Court in respect of the matter decided by arbitration and the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act (1996) of India shall apply to the same.
