

Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Mangalayatan University, Beswan, Aligarh
And
Imperial Society of Innovative Engineers, Jalandhar, Punjab

This Memorandum of Understanding for academic collaboration is made on June, 2016 between Mangalayatan University through its designated representative and Imperial Society of Innovative Engineers, Jalandhar Punjab through its authorized representative.

Whereas Mangalayatan University, **hence forth designated as Party A**, is a Private, self financing University, established by Act No.32 of 2006 of Govt. of Uttar Pradesh, and having its campus at Extended NCR, Mathura- Aligarh Highway, 33rd Milestone Aligarh. The University offers various courses as per UGC guidelines since its inception in 2007 including Post Graduate, Graduate and Diploma courses in various fields of engineering. The students of Mangalayatan University are well accepted in the Industry and other institutes. As per course curriculum of Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering & Electronics & Communications Engineering, the students perusing Degree programs have to undergo three modules of Industrial Training in their fourth, sixth & eighth semester for award of Degree to prepare them for today's requirement of market and to be industry ready.

Whereas Imperial Society of Innovative Engineers (ISIE), **hence forth designated as Party B**, is an organization which organizes Motorsports events and live projects based Industrial Training having its registered office at H.No-56, Moti Nagar Gurdware wali gali, Maqsudan Jalandhar, Punjab India- 144001 & corporate office at 2nd Floor opposite bus stand, Doaba Market, Jalandhar 144001. ISIE provides platform to the students for development and enhancement of their engineering skills as well as Managerial skills. They are developing platform specially for engineering students where they can easily face real time engineering problems and find the best solution. Now, after friendly negotiations, both parties reached the following agreement for the training and suitable employment of students from Mangalayatan University.

Following are the proposed training modules in the B.Tech. course; with mutually agreeable student strength:

- a) Four weeks summer training after IV Semester for students of Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics & Communications Engineering
- b) Six weeks Industrial Training after VI Semester for students of Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics & Communications Engineering
- c) Industrial Practice School in VIII Semester for students of Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics & Communications Engineering

A. It is understood that Party A as per the provisions of clause 7, sub clause (i) of The Mangalayatan University, Uttar Pradesh Act 2006, can cooperate, collaborate or associate with any other University or authority or Institution, in such manner and for such purpose as university may determine.

B. It is understood that both parties pursuant to the provisions contained in sub clause (i) of clause 7 of The Mangalayatan University, Uttar Pradesh Act 2006, have joined hands to collaborate for offering training courses to the students of Party A.

C. Students of Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics & Communication Engineering Degree Programs of Party A for Industrial Practice School.

1. It is understood that the students from Party A need to complete successfully their VII semester bachelor degree program at Party A. All students will clear all papers and will not have any back papers or will not have any detention in any paper upto end of VII semester. Then Party A will select and send the students to go through training program of six months duration at Party B. After successful completion of training program at Party B, students will be awarded a completion Certificate by Party B and the students will report back to Party A for clearing their VIII semester.

2. It is understood that the six months training imparted by Party B will be recognized as full Industrial Training by Party A as per course curriculum of semester VIII and students will suitably be examined as per evaluation scheme. The students can then obtain B.E. degree after successful completion of their study in both parties.

E. Obligations of Both Parties

1. Both parties agree that the students will abide by the rules, laws and regulations governing the respective institutions.

2. Either party agrees to inform immediately and in writing of any misdemeanor, accident, or serious health problems arising during the students' stay in the respective institutions.

3. Either parties agrees to provide accommodation for students on the campus during the period of study on suitable payment.

4. Both parties will invite each other to participate in the interaction with students each year where necessary. The faculty from Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics & Communications Engineering dept. of Party A will visit Party B at regular intervals to interact with their students and assess the progress of training.

F. Employment Assistance

The two parties agree that avenues for suitable employment of trained students will be explored and the students will be given an opportunity to take up employment in the suggested companies. Party B will offer suitable employment opportunities to the trained students of Party A.

G. Confidentiality

The two parties agree not to divulge any details of this program to the third parties--no matter what their identity and commit to complete confidentiality.

H. Breach Penalty

In the event of any disagreement arising between the parties concerning this agreement, both parties shall attempt to settle amicably. If a disagreement cannot be settled amicably this agreement will be terminated upon written notification by the injured party without prejudice or potential damages. However, both Parties will ensure that if a training is in process, then the training will be allowed to be completed without any prejudice and the disagreement will not come in the way of completion of ongoing training.

I. Jurisdiction

All matters, queries, dispute or differences, whatsoever, arising between the parties touching the construction, meaning, operation or effect of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) or out of or relating to this MOU or breach there of shall be settled through arbitration in accordance with the relevant Arbitration Act in force at such time. The Arbitration award shall be binding on both parties.

J. Others

This agreement, of which there are two copies, becomes effective as of signature of both parties. The effect of the agreement is three years. If there is not any disagreement after three years, the agreement will continue to be effective.
