MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN NATIONAL JALMA INSTITUTE FOR LEPROSY AND OTHER MYCOBACTERIAL DISEASES, (ICMR), AGRA, UP AND MANGALAYATAN UNIVERSITY, 33rd MILESTONE, ALIGARH-MATHURA HIGHWAY, BESWAN, ALIGARH-202145 (U.P.)

In accordance with the desire to explore, extend and strengthen the mutual Scientific relationship between Universities and National Scientific Institutes/ Laboratories of International repute; Mangalayatan University, Aligarh (established vide Act UP Act 32 of 2006 of Govt. of Uttar Pradesh, gazette notification 0. 362/VII-V-I (KA-12/2006) and recognized (under section 2f) by UGC vide its letter No- F.No. 9- (2007 (CPP-I-PU) dated: February 8, 2012 and National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases (NJIL and OMD), Agra, India, in order to share the facilities and expertise available in each other's Institution, herewith, sign a Memorandum of Understanding which reads as follows:

1.Responsibility of NJIL and OMD towards Mangalayatan University: National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra will provide regular, shortterm project training of 6 months duration to the students of Mangalayatan University, Aligarh in their areas of specialization on the request from the concerned Head of the department. A maximum of 05 students may be accommodated in every academic year after they qualify in the entrance or interview conducted by JALMA Agra in various laboratories of National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra. For such students, the guide would be from NJIL and OMD, Agra and co-guide recommended by the head of department would be from Mangalayatan University, Aligarh. The student trainees will be provided all the necessary assistance during their stay in the

Institute as per institute's norms. The student trainee of a six month project has to present his progress report-first at National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra after three months and for the final submission of project at 6 months, the presentation would be at Mangalayatan University, Aligarh. Furthermore, JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra will allow thirty (30) students of Mangalayatan University, Aligarh to visit the institute once in a year to build their exposure for research & available instrumentation.

2.Responsibilities of Mangalayatan University towards NJIL and OMD: Research students/ Scientists, working in different disciplines at National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra may register for Ph.D. degree (a maximum of three candidates per year) to be awarded by Mangalayatan University, Aligarh as per rules and regulation of Mangalayatan University, Aligarh and UGC.

For admission to Ph D, candidates shall have to go through an entrance examination to be conducted by the University or for the University, followed by interview. The candidates, who have qualified in the NET/JRF/SET/GATE/GPAT examinations of the apex bodies such as CSIR/UGC/ICAR/ICMR/DBT and DST inspired fellowship holders would be exempted from entrance examination. However, he/she has to appear before the interview board as per rules and regulation of University/ UGC.

The **Thesis Supervisor** of National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra will be of the level of Scientist "C' or above provided he/she fulfills the requisite qualifications to become a research supervisor. A faculty member of Mangalayatan University of the same or allied discipline will be **Thesis Co-Supervisor**. The list of qualified concerned scientists and their CVs will be provided (as and when required for registration of the PhD candidates under the guidance of the concerned scientists) by the Director, National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra to obtain formal approval from the concerned Research Degree Committee of Mangalayatan University, Aligarh.

3.Students doing Ph.D. at NJIL and OMD, Agra, shall have to demonstrate the relevant techniques (being used for their Ph. D. research) at the Department of Biotechnology, Mangalayatan University, Aligarh and/or at NJIL and OMD, Agra; whichever would be possible.

4. The scientists of National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra may deliver lectures in areas of their specialization to students of Mangalayatan University as visiting faculty on days and timings pre-arranged on mutual consent by Head of Department, National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra and concerned Head/Coordinator of Mangalayatan University. The scientist will be paid TA, DA & honorarium for lectures as per University rules.

5.B. Tech., Post graduate and Ph.D. students working at Mangalayatan University campus will be allowed to carry out a part of their research work in various laboratories of National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra related to mycobacterial diseases and all the necessary facilities except for the costly reagents and consumables. Accommodation on payment basis, if available will be provided by National JALMA Institute for Leprosy And Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra.

6.National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Agra and Mangalayatan University may apply for joint collaborative research projects to National and International funding agencies.

7.Data generated through such collaborative research will be published in peer reviewed journals jointly by the Head of the Department, Scientists and Research Scholars of both the Institutions.

8. The MOU will be effective for a period of five years from the date of signature,

9. This Memorandum of Understanding reflects the respective Institution's commitments to terms and conditions mentioned in MOU. This MOU may be amended or terminated at any time by either party provided that notice of termination or amendment is given by the notifying party to the other party before 3 months of the date on which the termination or the amendment is intended to become effective. The commitment made before the date of termination of MOU, will continue to be operative.
