MOU FOR ACADEMIC & RESEARCH COLLABORATION

hus Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for academic collaboration is made on 28 July 2020.

## Between

Mangalayatan University, Aligarh (MUA), a State Private University established under the provision of The Mangalayatan University Uttar Pradesh Act, 2006, and having its campus at Extended NCR, Mathura - Aligarh Highway, 33rd Milestone, Aligarh - 202145, Uttar Pradesh through Prof. KVSM Krishna, Vice Chancellor of the University.

Mangalayatan University, Jabalpur (MUJ), a State Private University established under the provision of Madhya Pradesh Niji Vishwavidyalaya (Sthapana Avam Sanchalan) Adhiniyam 2007 and having its Campus at NH-30, Mandla Road, Near Sharda Devi Mandir, Richai, Barela, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh-483001 through, Lt. Gen. (Dr) A. K. Misra, Vice Chancellor, of the University.

Both parties hereto, recognizing the benefits of collaboration wish to strengthen the ties between their respective institutions by entering into this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU").

## **NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED**

 The purpose of the MOU is to develop co-operation and promote mutual understanding and excellence in practice-based education, research and knowledge exchange between the Parties, so that the research and knowledge developed is used for further research and its application explored and exploited at regional, national and global levels.

2. Both Parties agree to carry out collaborative work by faculty and students in the

following areas:

a) To conduct extension activities for the upliftment of the local rural & urban people and surrounding areas, and improve their quality of life.

b) Collaborative research work.

c) Technological advancement of local industries.

d) Work on emerging technologies.

The outcome could be replicated in other parts of India or elsewhere in the world.

- 3. Both Parties to establish centers of cooperation through mutual agreement.
- 4. Both Parties may enter into joint research and development activities by initiating writing of detailed project report (DPR) and submission of the project proposal to the funding agencies like DBT, DST, CSIR, ICMR, ICAR, or any other national and/or international funding agencies. The idea is to explore joint sponsored research programmes and bring out intellect-driven product lines and patent generation. To this effect, both parties agree to exchange of information and to foster collaboration in research and educational training programmes.
- 5. In furtherance of the purpose, the Parties agree to develop the following activities in collaboration in areas of mutual academic interests:
  - a) Exchange of students and faculty for study programmes, research and other events to add up to the students' experience.
  - b) Identifying opportunities for conducting collaborative research and development. Identifying opportunities for organizing lectures, seminars, symposia and conferences.
  - c) Exchange of academic information and materials.
  - d) Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest.
  - e) Promoting other academic co-operation and collaboration as mutually agreed.
  - f) Provide necessary help in Organizing FDPs, SDPs and Personality Development Programmes at MUA & MUJ for enhancement of skills in respect of Faculty, Staff and Students.
  - g) Provide necessary support for establishment of Video satellite link and assistance in development of E-class rooms, Curriculum, establishment of research labs, Training & Placement and Library, etc.
- 6. The development and implementation of specific activities under the MOU subject to formal written agreements negotiated and entered into separately. These aggreement may detail financial arrangements, confidentiality, ownership and use of intellectual property, publication of articles or the work and relevant matters.

7. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in MOU shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Parties concerned. This MOU will not generate any financial liability or any resource commitment to either party.

8. Both Parties agree that staff and students of either institution engaged in activities under this MOU shall carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and

regulations of their respective institutes after full consultation and approval.

9. This MOU may only be amended by a written agreement signed by a duly authorized

representative of each Party. 10. This MOU shall commence on the date of its execution by the last Party to sign and shall remain in force for a period of five years. Each Party shall review the status of the MOU at least six months before the end of the five year period to determine whether it wishes the MOU to continue and, if so, whether any modifications are required. The period of validity of this MOU may only be extended by the mutual

11. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving six months notice in writing to the other. The termination of this MOU shall not affect the implementation of any specific activities initiated under it prior to such termination.

12. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationships between the Parties. The MOU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

13. In case of any dispute, the dispute may be referred to an arbitrator appointed by mutual consent.
